1. Wasp XT431 arrived at the Bournemouth Aviation Museum on 21 December 2013. It is now devoid of markings externally.
2. XX486 may well have moved from Bentwaters already as it was being prepared there for a customer elsewhere.
3. XZ589 is the first RAF Sea King to be withdrawn from use.
4. Following the withdrawal of the VC10, 1312 Flight is now using a TriStar for tanker/transport support in the Falkland Islands.
5. Lynx ZF557 is the first to wear markings for *Defender Flight*.
6. No 848 NAS disbanded at Yeovilton on 19 December 2013. With No 846 NAS now training on the Merlin, No 845 NAS is currently the only Sea King HC4 operator.
