Notes:

1. Spitfire LZ844 has been sold in the UK but its location at present is unconfirmed.
2. Tiger Moth G-AOIL, for so long a firm favourite at Compton Abbas, was involved in a fatal crash on 15 May 2011. The passenger died of his injuries shortly after and the pilot remains seriously injured in hospital.
3. Six of the former RAF Dominie trainers have now been sold, leaving just XS727 in store at Cranwell.
4. Harrier XW927 arrived by road at South Molton on 31 May 2011.
5. XX481 is one of a number of former RN Jetstreams which has been acquired by Everett Aero at Sproughton. At least one other machine has also made its way there by road.
6. From 8 April 19(R) Squadron operates solely the Hawk T2 while 208(R) Squadron operates the T1 although some of the latter still carry 19(R) Squadron markings.
7. Lynx XZ233 is now flying in a Navy blue colour scheme similar to that worn when the Lynx first entered service.
8. Lynx XZ250 wears 'Black Cats' colours and has gone on display at the former RNAS Portland. It is expected to remain there until at least the end of the sailing events of the 2012 Olympics, which will be staged nearby.
9. Lynx XZ722 wears a 'confuse a spotter' code in that this is the same code as worn by 815 NAS machine ZD258! XZ722 should be recoded shortly (please!)
10. 13 Squadron disbanded at Marham on 6 May 2011 and 14 Squadron at Lossiemouth on 15 April 2011. 13 Squadron will now become a Reaper UAV operator, based at RAF Waddington.
11. 76(R) Squadron disbanded at Linton-on-Ouse on 12 May 2011.
