1. With the recent departure of the last Typhoon T1 ZJ810 to Warton for T3 conversion, the RAF now operates a fleet of solely the T3 and FGR4 Typhoon variants.
2. ZK022 was the first Hawk T2 to emerge wearing markings of 4(R) Squadron. It would appear that the Hawk T2s will be coded alphabetically in order of serials with ZK010 being coded A, ZK011 coded B and so on.
