Notes:

- 1. Tiger Moth N9328/G-ALWJ is the third aircraft for Tiger Moth Training at Henstridge, joining BB807/G-ADWJ and NM138/G-ANEW.
- The museum at London Colney, according to its publicity, is strictly the 'de Havilland Aircraft Heritage Centre (incorporating the Mosquito Aircraft Museum)', or DHAHC for short.
- 3. Gazelle XZ321/G-CDNS has been repainted in the markings it wore during the Gulf War and is part of the newly formed Gazelle Squadron Display Team. The other aircraft in the Team are XX436/G-ZZLE, ZB627/G-CBSK and ZB647/G-CBSF. The Team also has Gazelle AH1 XW849 on rebuild, which will gain a UK civil registration shortly.
- 4. Lynx HAS3S XZ257 has returned to Yeovilton now made to look like a Wildcat. It no longer wears its registration externally.
- 5. The forward fuselage of former ETPS BAC 1-11 ZE432 was finally transported by road to the Bournemouth Aviation Museum on 30 April 2014. This means that at last an example of the type will be preserved at its birthplace.
- 6. Tucano ZF140 is the second of the 2014 display aircraft, also wearing 'Lest We Forget' markings.
- 7. Typhoon ZJ936 has lost its colourful markings and has been returned to normal marks.
- Typhoon ZK308 now wears D-Day stripes on the tail and under wing and the code worn by Typhoon MN526 of No 198 Squadron in Summer 1944.
- 9. Typhoon ZK342 wears special marks for the 100th anniversary of 6 Squadron. It has a sand camouflage fin and spine and `100 Years' in red on the tail.
- 10. Voyager MRTT024 is currently at Manchester being sprayed. It should become ZZ338 (G-VYGI) in due course.
- 11. Finally, it is with regret that we note the crash of an Army Lynx AH9 in Southern Afghanistan on 26 April 2014, with the loss of five service personnel. In this year when we are especially remembering those who died in World War I, it is poignant to note but worth remembering that men and women are still dying to keep us free.
