Notes:

1. Chipmunk WP901 was cancelled from the UK register as sold in Belgium on 19 January 2022. As yet its new identity has not been forthcoming.
2. Hawk T1A XX221 now sports a red tail and '1917 - 2022' on the fuselage to denote the passing shortly of No 100 Sqn RAF. The press release about this aircraft states that it is eventually destined for the *Red Arrows*.
3. BAe 146 C3 ZE707 was the latest to be withdrawn from use when it arrived at Cranfield on 22 February 2022. It is expected to eventually go to Australia.
4. Hawk 167 ZB136 was delivered to Leeming on 7 February 2022.
