**Notes:**

1. A major element of this update (the first to update 'Military Aircraft Markings 2022', due out in a few days) is, of course related to the withdrawal from service of the Hawk T1 with No 100 Sqn RAF, the Centre for Aviation Medicine and No 736 NAS. At the moment not all aircraft have moved to their final destinations, and it is expected that those still at Culdrose or Leeming will now be preserved or depart by road. With the end of Hawk T1 operations it sadly saw the end of No 100 Sqn RAF and No 736 NAS RN.
2. Chinook ZA718 was transported by road to the RAF Museum at Cosford on 16 March 2022 for preservation. It had only recently been on the conversion line at Boscombe Down.
3. The last two RAF BAe 146s were disposed of recently, with ZE708 going to Cranfield on 11 March 2022 and ZE700 to St. Athan on 17 March.
4. The latest batch of F-35B Lightning IIs, ZM159, ZM160 and ZM161, were finally delivered to RAF Marham on 3 March 2022.
5. Apache AH-64Es ZM702 and ZM716 were delivered by air to Mildenhall on 17 March 2022 and thence to Wattisham on 21 March.
